

# Trick One Tricks

## Basics (Second Hand Low)

	A	B	C	D	E	F
Dummy:	♠K42	♠Q42	♠K42	♠Q93	♠A105	♠Q10
Lead:	♠6	♠6	♠Q	♠J	♠6	♠6
Declarer:	♠J5	♠J53	♠1076	♠K76	♠J4	♠A3

In A-D (presume a suit contract) play low from dummy. In E, play low, but unblock the jack from hand. In F, it is a guess.

## Using Your Spots

	G	H	I	J	K	L
Dummy:	♥K102	♥Q42	♥AJ4	♥AQ6	♥K105	♥AQ2
Lead:	♥3	♥6	♥5	♥3	♥6	♥6
Declarer:	♥A84	♥1075	♥97	♥1052	♥84	♥943

In all cases, play low from dummy – for reasons as explained in lesson.

## Trick One Tricks (Continued)

### Trick One at Notrump

	M	N	O	P	Q	R
Dummy:	♦ 102	♦ 102	♦ J32	♦ AKQ84	♦ J32	♦ AQ2
Lead:	♦ 5	♦ 5	♦ 5	♦ 5	♦ 5	♦ 5
Declarer:	♦ AJ4	♦ AK4	♦ A76	♦ 93	♦ A96	♦ 74

Play low in M, P (unblock from hand), Q and R for reasons explained in the lesson.

### Logic and Deception

	S	T	U	V	W
Dummy:	♣ Q54	♣ AK5	♣ 1053	♣ 62	♣ 32
Lead:	♣ 9	♣ 4	♣ A	♣ K	♣ Q
Declarer:	♣ AJ102	♣ Q72	♣ Q82	♣ AJ83	♣ AK6

Play low on S so as to not waste the queen on a short king with RHO.

Against notrump, win the ace on T and falsecard with the 7.

Falsecard with your 8 on U & V to make a continuation more likely.

On W (and in general) win with your highest of touching cards to best confuse the defense.
